

What you can Expect


- A full submersion experience where you will be learning and integrating your new skill set in real life situations.

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Curriculum: Taking horses from wild to mild!


This program is designed to help Develop and elevate your horsemanship. Here is a list of thing you will have to opportunity to experience and work through

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Required Horsemanship Skills


- Walk/Trot/ Canter


- Willing to Laugh, Learn and Listen
